

# Cragg Challenge 2020

## Coronavirus Update



The Cragg Challenge 2020 will be **postponed until next year**.

We will let you know as soon as we feel confident to announce the rescheduled date.

Any entries will be carried forward to the new date, if you have already entered you don't need to do anything further. If when we announce the new date you cannot make it, or would prefer not to attend the event on the new date, please get in touch.

Like many event organisers, we have tried to wait as long as possible in the hope that the situation would not develop as far as it has. At this time the most important consideration is the safety of all involved: participants, volunteers, medical team and the public at large.

Our decision has been influenced by:

- A big part of our event involves local school children taking part in the 'Collinge Climb' relay. We do not want to further complicate their work in a difficult year.
- A minimum number of volunteers are needed for the event, we can not guarantee this at the moment.
- We rely on support from many local organisations including councils and businesses who may need to consider the use of their resources.
- All medical support is under strain and our event is a low priority at this time.
- The government has not yet made a statement about events this far ahead but we believe this is the best option.

Like other event organisers we have not taken this decision lightly. We hope that you understand our reasons and look forward to welcoming you to the next Cragg Challenge in 2021.
